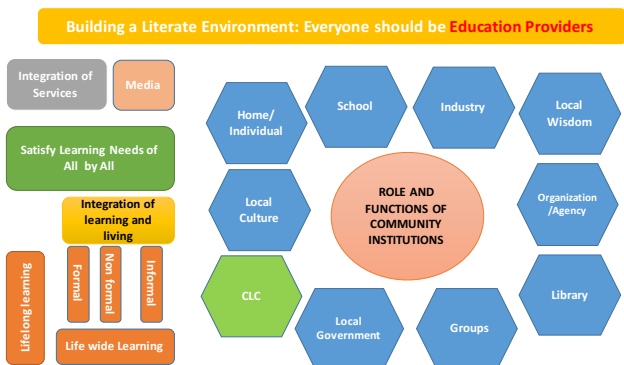
## Framework for Creating Literate Environment
