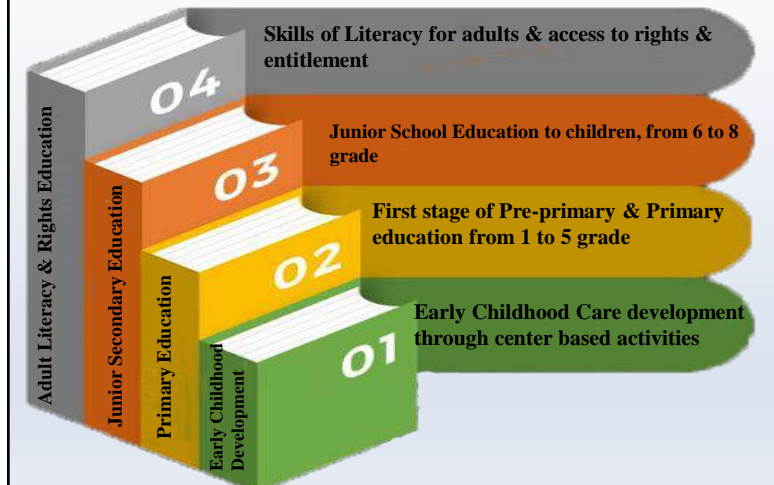

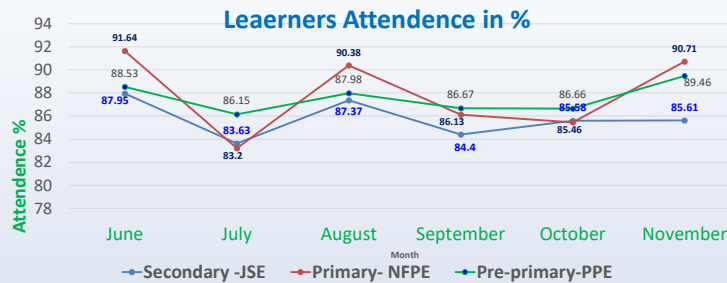

- Everyday 95 outreach street children are getting Lunch everyday from DAM Education Sector
- 10 Street girls are getting night shelter
- **989 young Adolescents** have got Vocational Training

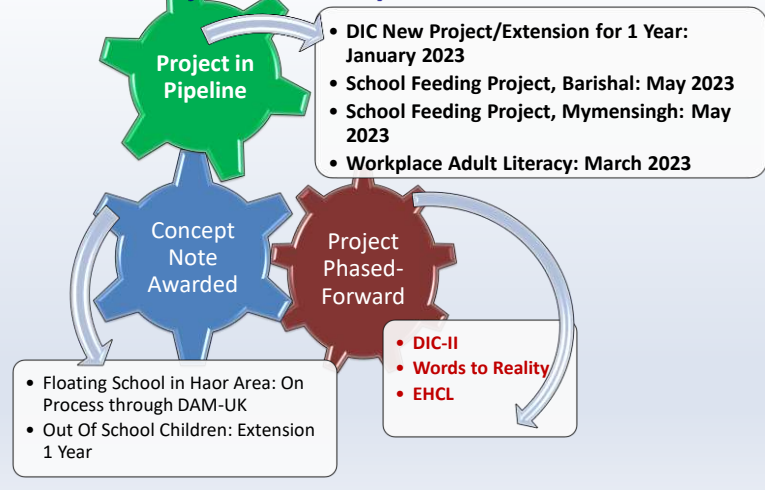

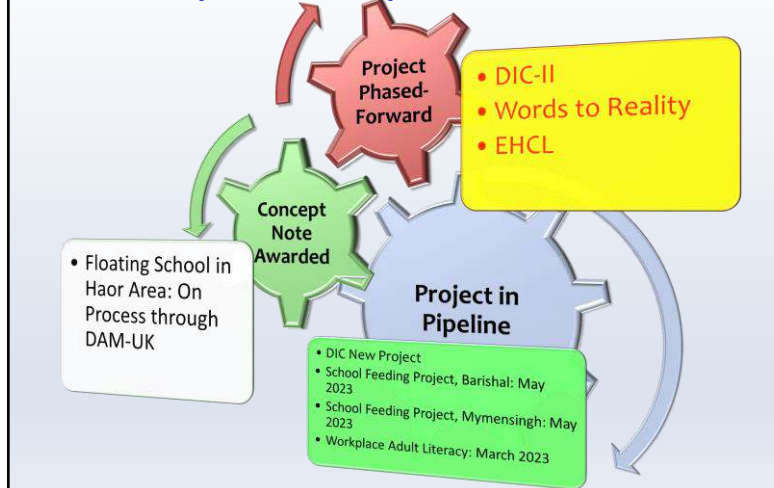
### Major Challenges Faced
